Weeks 1 & 2 (June 29 - July 3 & July 6 – 10)

### **Artists Around the Globe and Beyond!**

Come along as we travel to meet some famous **artists from cultures around the world** through joyful, hands-on art experiences! We'll explore different styles, materials, and ways of creating while expressing our own unique ideas and creativity. Along the way, we'll also make simple connections to where the art comes from, helping us to build an early awareness of our wide and wonderful world!

Week 3 (July 13 – 17)
